This work comprises of a Ritornello (THE MILKY WAY) punctuated by three soloistic constellations (ORION, THE PLOUGH and PEGASUS) for which performing materials and instructions are separately printed, and which require the performers to execute composed solo fragments freely, in spontaneous juxtaposition with one another, in the manner of mobiles.

SKIN: Side Drum, Bass Drum, 1 or 2 Pedal Timpani, 5 Tom-Toms

WOOD: Wood Block, Marimba

METAL: Suspended Cymbals, 2 or 3 Steel Springs, 2 Tam-Tams, Hi-hat,
Waterphone (played with a bow and stand mounted to allow for movement of water inside),
Mark Tree, Vibraphone, Crotales

Duration: 10 minutes approx.

SYMBOLS USED IN THE SCORE

 woodwind instruments: these notes are to be played staccatissimo, as fast as possible, double-tongue and triple-tongue, but not flutter-tongue.

s.p. sul pont.

n.v. non vibrato

 over a fermata: this indicates that the fermata is optional, and the performer may wait ad lib. for a suitable pause before resuming the fragment being played, or not wait at all, if that is musically appropriate.

 diamond shaped notes (piano) indicate that the strings are to be plucked directly by the finger-nail.

 quarter flat

 three-quarters flat

 quarter sharp

 three quarters sharp

NOTATION:

The full score of the Ritornello (The Milky Way) is in C, with the following usual transpositions:
Crotales sound two octaves higher than written.
Harp harmonics sound one octave higher than written.

These will be determined at the time of the first rehearsal by the composer in consultation with the conductor and the performers.
